**1. Summary of last year's work**

We shared gift and weeding policies (<http://lib.nmsu.edu/depts/reference/ccd.html>); came up with a plan to share information on serials cancellations and high dollar serials; looked at EBSCO databases for a possible consortium subscription.

**2. Updates**

The CCD web site now has the serials cancellations, 1995-present and the serials titles exceeding \$1,000 spreadsheets. Bruce Neville shared a reworked version of the cancellation spreadsheet, an A-Z list by title with columns for each institution, and a reworked version of the over \$1,000 list. Both of these are now on the group's web site.

**3. Gold Rush demo**

We looked at UNM's Gold Rush database with the view of possibly using it as a statewide serials list. UNM is using also Gold Rush I as a mechanism to track database licensing information (ILL requirements, course packs, electronic reserves, etc.)

**4. New ILL group**

We discussed the possibility of sharing our next meeting with the ILL group so this group will be informed of the work the CCD is doing and the direction we are heading. It will be helpful to communicate closely with this new group as we are all facing serials cancellations and we will need to think creatively about how to share resources. It was suggested to check with the Deans and Directors group before going forward with our joint meeting idea.

**5. Last copy in the state agreement**

We discussed this idea and determined it would be helpful to have such a document especially in terms of serials cancellations. We will gather and share lists of degrees offered as a starting point for our focus on serials.

**6. Top InterLibrary Loan requested serial titles**

Christee King suggested sharing our top 20 serial titles we request through interlibrary loan.

**7. Desiderata database list**

We decided that each institution would come up with a top 10 list of databases that we would like to try to purchase consortially.
