### **NMSU Library Offers Two New Web Databases**

The New Mexico State University Library announces that LEXIS-NEXIS Academic Universe and Ethnic NewsWatch are now available through the Library's recently redesigned home page. These databases are accessible to NMSU main campus users via the Article Databases page at <http://lib.nmsu.edu/article.html>. Off-campus users can connect to the web through the NMSU Aggie Access software available from NMSU Computing and Networking.

The academic version of the LEXIS-NEXIS service allows users to locate full-text and abstracts of comprehensive news, business, and legal information. Users can search a variety of trade and academic journals, foreign and domestic news sources, regional US news services, radio and television transcripts, and federal and state case law. In addition, medical, legislative, and industry news, and annual reports from the Securities and Exchange Commission are available. Newspapers are updated several times daily, and wire services hourly. Search forms offer easy fill-in-the-blank access, and full-text articles can be downloaded, printed or emailed.

Ethnic NewsWatch provides access to over 300,000 full-text articles from over 200 newspapers and magazines of the ethnic, minority, and native press. The web product, which replaces a CD-ROM version, will make ethnic information easier to access and search. Ethnic NewsWatch has a Spanish language search capability, as well as Spanish language content including three daily Spanish language newspapers.
