## University Library Service Points to Merge

This summer, in an effort to improve and centralize user services, several service points at the New Mexico State University Library will undergo merges. The changes are effective July 1, at the beginning of NMSU's second summer session.

All reference services and collections formerly in Branson and Zuhl libraries will be consolidated on the first floor of Zuhl Library. The Reference and Research Services staff is exploring new models of reference service delivery. The consolidation will also enable staff to build the library instruction program, strengthen collection development and enhance outreach efforts.

The circulation desks at both Branson and Zuhl libraries will become Customer Service Desks. Interlibrary loan/document delivery will be located on the first floor of Zuhl Library, and it will be renamed Information Delivery Services to reflect a broader scope of services.

All services of the Archives and Special Collections Department will be provided through a search room on the fourth floor east of Branson Library. The Special Collections search room on the second floor of Branson Library will be closed. New service hours for Archives and Special Collections will be Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. through 4:00 p.m.
