## University Library Service Points Undergo Changes

Several public service points at the New Mexico State University Library have undergone changes. The changes, which resulted from an effort to improve and centralize user services, went into effect on July 1, 2004.

All reference services and collections formerly in Branson and Zuhl libraries have been consolidated on the first floor of Zuhl Library. The centralization will enable reference staff to place additional emphasis on building the library instruction program, developing the Library's collections and enhancing outreach to the campus community.

Staff that process federal government documents and maps have been brought together in a new service unit that will also provide research assistance for these sources. The service point for government documents and maps assistance has been established on the second floor west of Branson Library. Assistance will be available from 10:00 a.m. through 3:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

The circulation desk at Branson Library has expanded services, and it is now operating as a general information service point. Assistance with periodicals will continue to be available at the periodicals service desk on the first floor west of Branson Library. Interlibrary loan/document delivery has relocated to the first floor of Zuhl Library, and has been renamed Information Delivery Services to reflect a broader scope of services, including Pegasus delivery and pickup services for faculty and Ph. D. candidates.

All services of the Archives and Special Collections Department are now provided through a search room on the fourth floor east of Branson Library. The former Special Collections search room on the second floor east of Branson Library is no longer open. New service hours for Archives and Special Collections are Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. through 4:00 p.m.
