The NMSU Doña Ana Community College's mission is to be a responsive and accessible learning-centered community college that provides educational opportunities to a diverse community of learners in support of workforce and economic development.

Established in 1973, NMSU DACC is a **comprehensive, multi-campus college**, with two campuses and centers in Las Cruces, Anthony, Sunland Park and White Sands. NMSU DACC offers more than 40 certificate and associate degree programs. It also offers dual-credit and Adult Basic Education/GED courses. Its dedicated faculty, staff, and students enable DACC to rank in the top 5 percent nationally on the CCSSE's Support for Learners and Student Effort.

NMSU DACC is seeking **independent accreditation** from HLC and will be visited by a team of four HLC peer reviewers April 28-30. NMSU Alamogordo and NMSU Carlsbad are independently accredited by HLC.

Through a participative, evidence-based self-study, NMSU DACC achieved a greater understanding of its strengths and opportunities for improvement. This thorough self-study resulted in action plans for the five HLC criteria and an expansion of **assessment of student learning** for general education and career programs.
