

Accreditation: The HLC Visit

Peer Review Visit: New Mexico State University's Las Cruces and Grants campuses will be visited by a Higher Learning Commission (HLC) peer review team April 28-30, 2008. The Doña Ana campus, which is seeking independent accreditation, will be visited by a separate HLC team at the same time.

The Process: Prior to the visit, the HLC team will have received our Self-Study Report and will have had access to documents on the Web or in other electronic formats. During the visit, the team will validate the content of the report including strengths we have declared and data that support them, as well as concerns that need attention or issues that may confront us in the future. HLC team members will meet with individuals and groups from across the campuses. After the visit, the team will prepare a written report that the university may respond to before going to the HLC Board of Directors for action.
