*NMSU Grants was established as a community college campus of New Mexico State University in 1968 through the cooperative efforts of NMSU and what is now, Grants/Cibola County Public Schools.*

NMSU Grants takes pride in the **quality programming and service** provided to its community. The campus balances the provision of transferable academic programs with preparing students to directly enter the workforce.

The campus is situated in one of the most culturally diverse regions in New Mexico. NMSU Grants has the unique distinction of being the only Native American and Hispanic Serving Institution in the country. In 2007, based on the national Community College Survey of Student Engagement, NMSU Grants was the only New Mexico community college to be named one of the **top 30 community colleges** in the country.

Since its last review, NMSU Grants has made its dual enrollment program more accessible by gaining Regents' approval to waive tuition for dual enrollees; expanded its ABE/GED program; improved computer and library research facilities; and acquired a workforce training facility for the Small Business Development Center. NMSU Grants continues to **collaborate with potential employers** regarding focused career/technical education for newly arriving industries such as uranium mining.
