Interlibrary Loan is a free service for all NMSU faculty, students and staff. Requesting copies of articles that are in journals to which we don't subscribe is easy with database links provided through ILLiad. But first, register to use it - set up your Interlibrary Loan account *before* requesting any articles at <http://illiad.nmsu.edu/>

Information Delivery Services (IDS) is the new name for Interlibrary Loan and Pegasus Delivery and Pick-up Services. These two complementary services combine to provide NMSU faculty and students access to needed research information whether owned by the library or another organization.

Interlibrary Loan (ILL) is a service based on resource sharing between libraries, supplemented by external information delivery vendors. ILL provides access to a vast amount of information available across the globe.

Pegasus will deliver and pick up NMSU library owned and/or ILL materials to departmental offices, or other designated campus locations, for faculty and Ph.D. candidates. Delivery services are also provided to off-campus faculty and distance education students.
