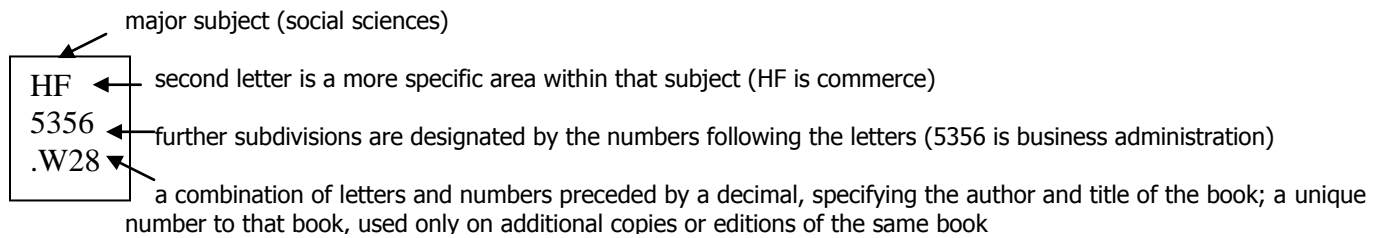


HOW TO FIND THE LIBRARY'S BOOKS, DVDs, ETC.
