

MARIACHI MATERIALS IN THE NMSU LIBRARY



The project "Expanding Southwestern Cultural Resources : Development of a Mariachi Collection at New Mexico State University Library" will allow for the acquisition of material related to Mariachi music, including sound recordings, pedagogical materials, books, scores, and theses and dissertations.
