
Final Project: 2nd Draft

For your second draft of the final project you will submit:

1. **14 sources.** Provide at least 14 of the **best, most appropriate and most useful** sources you have found to date on your topic. Consider the following points
 - ▶ You may submit more than 14 sources.
 - ▶ Use the citation form on the course web page. You will find it at: <http://lib.nmsu.edu/instruction/lsc311/02fall2000/citeform.html>
 - ▶ You may submit the same 8 sources as you submitted for your first draft along with at least 6 new sources. But if you have found more appropriate sources within the last month than any of those submitted the first time around, by all means submit the best sources.
2. **Photocopies of all your sources.** All 14 of them. For books, provide the title page; for journal, magazine and newspaper articles, provide the first page of the article.
3. **First draft submission.** Include the citations (from the citeform.html) and the photocopies of all sources you submitted for your first draft. If you are including these in your 14 sources, you do not need to make an extra copy. But if you have discarded some of these sources in favor of more appropriate ones, include the citation form and the photocopies for the discarded sources.
4. **Written narrative of one section for the final essay.** For your final essay you have three separate sections: Introduction, Description and Evaluation. Submit a written narrative for one of these sections. For guidelines on what to include, see the final project description at: http://lib.nmsu.edu/instruction/lsc311/02fall2000/final_project.html.
